From the Principal

We have some exciting news to share. We have a number of "New Buses" joining our fleet over the coming months. Brand new 40 seat buses, Bendy buses and Double Deckers!

Some of our existing buses will also be changing their look - from Bayes colours and name into the Auckland Transport branding. We will still be offering the same great and reliable service as normal, the school runs will continue to operate exactly as they are now - picking up and dropping off at the same stops. And our Charter work will also operate to the same great standard it has always been.
